What is Bullying?



SEVERAL TIMES ON PURPOSE

Bullying is when somebody <u>keeps being mean</u> to you to hurt your body or your feelings

It can be:

- Verbal: name calling, teasing, spreading rumours.
- Emotional: leaving you out, saying nasty things about you to others, hurting your feelings, making threats.
- Physical: punching, kicking, hitting, pushing, spitting.
- Cyber: Saying unkind things online, via text, groupchat
- Prejudice: Calling you names because of who you are: the colour of your skin, religion, ethnicity, sexuality, gender, special educational need or disability.

It is not Bullying when:

- · Someone hurts you by accident.
- · Someone is mean one time.
- · You and a friend have a fight or disagreement.



· A child with special needs does something that upsets or hurts you, without meaning to.

What should I do if I am being bullied?

Speak Up and Get Help! 1. Say NO ✓ Ask them to STOP. STOP



- 2. Move away: * Walk away and ignore them.
- 3. Tell: Tell SOMEONE

Tell a teacher. Tell a parent. Tell any trusted adult.

What should I do if I see Bullying?

Be an Upstander: Stand up for the person being bullied.

Get Help!

- . Tell a teacher or trusted adult
- Tell a parent
- Help the person being bullied
- Be brave speaking up is kind and strong!
